

## The Stagnant Alternative: Fee-for-Service Medicaid

- One-size-fits-all government healthcare.
- No accountability to ensure individuals are receiving appropriate care.
- No incentive for innovation.
- Limited prevention and early treatment of chronic conditions.
- Providers are paid for the volume rather than the value of service.
- The state's budget responsibility is unpredictable.



## The Value of Ohio Medicaid Managed Care

**Medicaid managed care plans deliver access to quality health care to those who need it most while delivering savings for Ohio taxpayers**

### Key Benefits of Medicaid Managed Care

#### Quality

In 2019 and 2020, all Ohio Medicaid plans **scored higher than the national average** and the large state subgroup averages on the National Committee for Quality Assurance metrics.



#### Designed for Excellence

- + Medicaid managed care plans are paid a monthly capitated premium.
- + Medical needs of enrollees are covered.
- + The state pays a fixed amount, providing budget stability.
- + Plans accept the risk and manage the costs.



## Access

Managed care plans coordinate healthcare services for nearly **9 in 10 of all Ohioans enrolled in Medicaid.**

- + Children and families
- + Aged, blind and disabled
- + Low-income childless adults

The more than **2.7 million Medicaid managed care members** have access to a robust networks of providers to meet their diverse needs.



## Savings

Medicaid plans have generated an **average savings to taxpayers of more than 15%, freeing up more than \$4 billion** for other priorities each state budget cycle.


### Managed care saves public resources by:

## Ohio's Medicaid Dollar at Work:

More than **86% of every Medicaid managed care dollar** is directly invested in health care services for Medicaid members.
